

Kismet Quilts

"Bold Beauty" using the Churn Dash

Requirements for Quilts:

- 16 – 8" Churn Dash Blocks;
- 9 – 8" Focal Fabric (we used Shiki from In The Beginning) Blocks;
- 6 - 8-1/2" Focal Fabric blocks cut in half for inset triangles
- 1 – 8-1/2" Focal Fabric block cut in four quarter square triangles for corners

Sew blocks in an alternating pattern so they are on point.

Sew a half square triangle to the end of each row.

Sew a quarter square triangle to each corner.

Trim your quilt top, Voila, it should measure 43" square.

Inner Border

Requirements – from Fabric #2 (purple):

- 2 Strips each 2-1/2"x 43"
- 2 Strips each 2-1/2"x 47"

Sew the two 43" strips to opposite sides of quilt. Then attach the two 47" strips to the remaining two sides of quilt.

Outer Pieced Border

Requirements for small squares:

- 8 strips x 4" Focal Fabric
- 4 strips x 2" Fabric #3 Orange

Sew strips together in sets of three with the orange in the centre. Sub cut each strip into 21 - 2" pieces.

Join subsets right sides together offsetting the crosscuts and matching seams.

Sew pairs into fours and fours into eight continue until the strip has 21 units. You should have four strips. Trim long uneven sides of two (2) strips ONLY to 5" width. Attach these two strips to opposite sides of your quilt top.

Requirements for large square

- 2 Strips x 4" Focal Fabric
- 1 Strip x 3-1/2" Fabric #3 Orange

Sew these 3 strips into one set with the orange in the centre. Sub cut into 4 – 3-1/2" pieces. Attach one large square to each end of your remaining strips. Trim long uneven sides of each strip to 5" width and sew to remaining sides of your quilt top.

Hurray you should now have a finished quilt top as shown!!
